



## Niagara Dance Centre Competition Makeup Application

<b>Directions</b>	<b>Picture</b>
Step #1: Apply base foundation, concealer, and powder.	
Step #2: Apply black liner to the “waterline” of the eye, (aka. the inside part of the upper lid).	
Step #3: Apply the lightest shade of the eye shadow all of the eyelid.	

Step #4: Use the dark purple, (on the bottom right,) and apply it to just the lid of the eye. Slightly above the natural eye fold. Make sure you have a lot of eye shadow on the brush so it is nice and dark.



Step #5: If you have a smudge brush use it to apply the dark gray shade slightly above the crease of the eye.



Step #6: Load your brush with the pink shade and apply it over the dark purple. Beware of excess eye shadow falling below your eye!



Step #7: Use the lightest shadow again and start by applying it under the brow bone. Continue blending it downward to soften the colors on the whole eye. (Make sure you do not look like you have two black eyes!)



Step #8: Apply black eyeliner, liquid or solid, to the upper lash line. Do not apply too far past the end of your lashes, (don't "cat" the liner out). Make sure it's a thicker line.

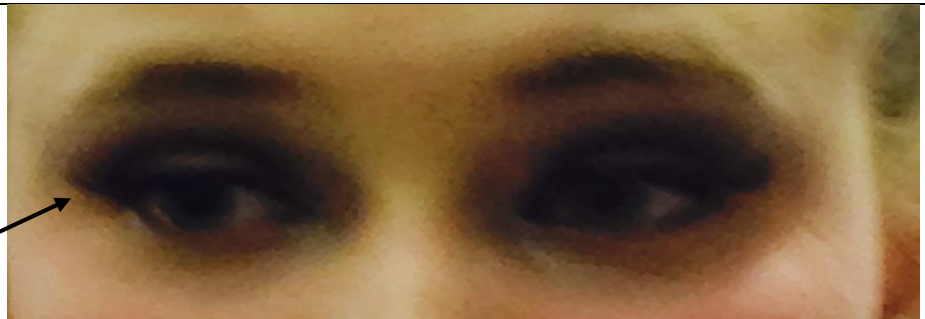


Step #9: Take the light silver shade and apply it to your inner corner of your eye. This is to highlight your eye.



Step #10: Touch up the upper and lower eyeliner.

Step #11: Apply eyelashes. Put a light amount of glue on to the eyelash. Close eye and apply in the lash line. Keep the eye closed while the glue dries.





Step #12: Apply mascara from lash line to the tip of the lash.

Step #13: Generously apply the blush to the face. Remember that if you do not apply enough, Jen attack you and will fix it for you!

Step #14: Apply lipstick before you go on stage!
